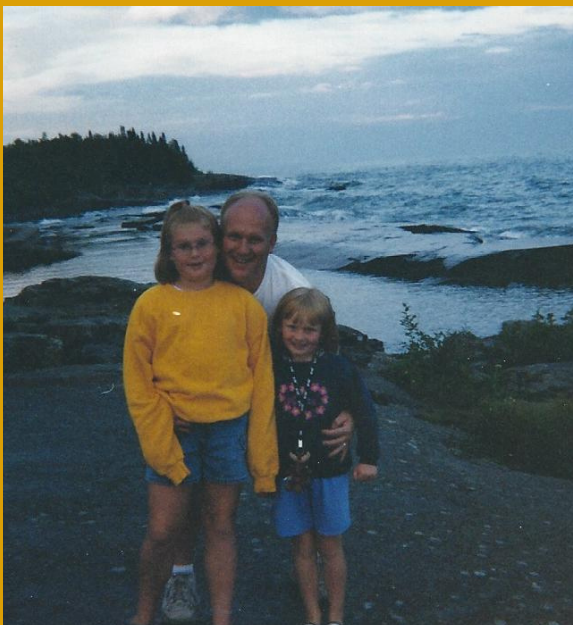
Our Family and Traditions
